Trial Roll Call: **8:30 AM - ALL Hounds**, early Roll for Field Committee, followed by draw.

If a hound passes the required QC Test and the owner/handler wishes to enter the subsequent trial, the AKC Coursing Director has granted this club permission to accept trial entries following the test. Entries in this case will be accepted for a period of 15 minutes immediately following the announced finish of the QC Test.

Conditions of Entry

- * Hounds must be one year of age or older on the day of the trial. All hounds will run twice, in trios if possible or braces unless excused, dismissed or disqualified.
- * Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched after a 5-minute grace period.
- * Bitches in season and lame hounds will be excused (with entry refunded).
- * All hounds will be examined at inspection for breed disqualifications.
- * Spayed or neutered hounds, without breed disqualifications, may be entered.

Eligible Breeds and Registry

Afghan Hounds, Azawakhs, Basenjis, Borzois, Cirneco Dell'Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Portuguese Podengo Pequeno, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Sloughis and Whippets that are one year of age or older, that have been registered with The American Kennel Club, or part of an AKC-registered litter, or otherwise, if whelped outside of the United States of America and owned by a resident of the USA, or of a country with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration and is registered with that registry, or that have been granted an Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP) or Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL), are eligible to participate in lure coursing tests and trials and be awarded the prefix title of Field Champion and the suffix titles of Junior Courser, Qualified Courser, Senior Courser or Master Courser. Those sighthounds enrolled in AKC's FSS (Norrbottenspets, Peruvian Inca Orchid, Portugese Podengos (Medino and Grande) Thai Ridgebacks) which are eligible to compete in Conformation Miscellaneous class are eligible to compete in lure coursing tests and trials and will be awarded the suffix titles of Junior Courser, Qualified Courser, Senior Courser or Master Courser only.

Spayed or neutered hounds are eligible to participate. Monorchid and cryptorchid hounds are ineligible to participate. Hounds may not be entered as "registration or ILP pending". Breed disqualifications apply.

Portugese Podengos Pequenos and FSS breeds are not eligible to compete for Best in Field.

Any person, upon reasonable complaint, may be asked to leave the grounds of the field trial by the Field Committee and may be disciplined by the AKC. Children must be under control of their parent(s) or guardian(s) at all times.

Stakes Offered

AKC JC and QC TESTS – offered both days

The **JUNIOR COURSER TEST** is open to all hounds of an eligible breed at least 1 year of age. A hound running alone shall receive a certification from a judge on one date and a second certification from a different judge at a later date, stating that the hound completed at least a 600 yard course with a minimum of four turns. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption.

The **QUALIFIED COURSER TEST** is open to all hounds of an eligible breed at least 1 year of age. A hound (Qualifying Hound) running with another hound of the same breed - or another breed with a similar running style - (Testing Hound) shall receive certification from a licensed judge. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption, sufficiently course the lure and not course the Testing Hound. The judge will certify that the Qualifying Hound ran cleanly and did not appear to present a hazard to the Testing Hound at any point in the qualifying course. This certificate is required to enter a hound in an Open Stake.

The handler presenting the Qualifying Hound shall be responsible for providing the Testing Hound for the qualifying course. Upon successful completion of the Qualified Courser test, the judge completes a certificate and awards it to the handler.

This certificate must be submitted to the host club with the hound's first entry in an Open Stake. The certificate must be included when the results of the trial are sent to the AKC.

AKC REGULAR STAKES:

OPEN: Open to all sighthounds that have attained at least one of the following: AKC Qualified Courser Title, CKC Field Champion Title, ASFA FCh Title. Championship points may be awarded from this stake. Whippets who have earned an AKC Field Championship are not eligible to enter Open.

OPEN VETERAN: Open to all sighthounds, which are eligible to enter either Open or Special Stake, and are of Veteran age as determined by their Parent Breed Club. Championship or LCX points may be awarded from this stake.

SPECIAL: Open to all sighthounds that are eligible to enter the Open stake and have earned their AKC Field Championship titles. LCX points may be awarded from this stake.

SINGLES STAKE:

Singles: Will be offered. Open to all sighthounds. Sighthounds with breed disqualifications are eligible to enter.

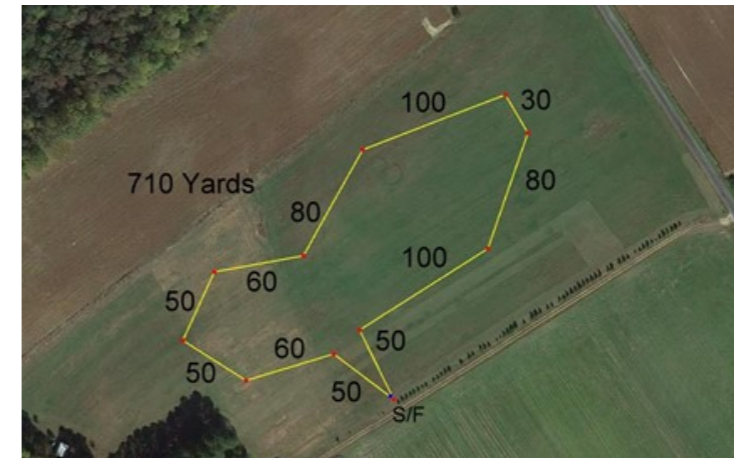
Hounds under disqualification from AKC, ASFA, or CKC Field Trials may NOT be entered.

BIF will be offered.

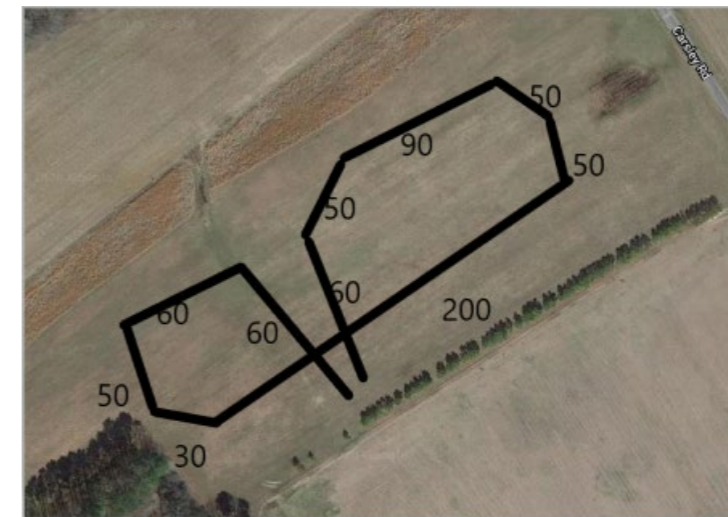

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL

From the North -From Hopewell, take Rt. 10 East for 29.7 miles. Turn right onto Martin Luther King Highway (VA 40) for five miles, turn left onto Carsley Road (VA 615) for 3.7 miles. Then turn right onto Carsley Road and field will be on the right in about 1/2 mile.
From the South -From Emporia, get on Rt. 95 North towards Richmond for 19.8 miles, take Exit 31 (VA 40) towards Waverly/Sussex Courthouse for 28.1 miles. Turn right onto Carsley Road (VA 615) for 3.7 miles. Turn right again onto Carsley Road and field will be on the right in about 1/2 mile.
From Jamestown/Williamsburg - Take VA 31 towards the Jamestown/Scotland Ferry. Ferry is free, but check schedule for departure times. Continue on VA 31 for 14.6 miles, then turn right onto Carsley Road. The field is on the left in 2.9 miles. Ferry schedule can be found here: <http://www.virginiadot.org/travel/ferry-jamestown.asp>
From Suffolk - Take 460 West for 20.7 miles. Turn right onto VA 31 for about 5 miles. Turn left onto Carsley Road for 2.9 miles to the field on the left.
From Hampton/Newport News -Take the James River Bridge (Rt 17S), then turn right onto Brewer's Neck Blvd. (Rt. 32/258) for 2.8 miles. Turn right onto Benn's Church Blvd. (Rt. 10) for 22 miles. Turn left at the light in Surry (VA 10/31) for 10.3 miles. Turn right onto Carsley Road for 2.9 miles to the field on the left.
From Portsmouth/Chesapeake – Take 17 North into Isle of Wight County (Carrollton). Turn left onto Brewers Neck Blvd. (Rt. 32/258) for 2.8 miles. Turn right onto Benn's Church Blvd. (Rt. 10) for 22 miles. Turn left at the light in Surry (VA 10/31) for 10.3 miles. Turn right onto Carsley Road for 2.9 miles to the field on the left.

AKC Lure Coursing COVID-19 Event Waiver

1. SHOT club members and all exhibitors will follow **State** and **local** guidelines.
2. All Field Committee and Lure Operators will wear facial coverings. All participants will wear facial coverings. The club will not provide facial coverings.
3. No food will be served, bring your own breakfast, lunch and dinner. Please bring your own food, water and shade for yourself and your dogs.
4. We ask that you park at a safe distance away from each other.
5. Maintain 6 feet of distance in the roll call line. The roll call committee will wear facial coverings. We will ask the owners of females to wipe their dogs and show the inspection committee the tissue.
6. We will have some hand sanitizer or wet wipes in various locations for use. However we strongly encourage you to bring and use your own hand-sanitizer when possible.
7. We will prop open the porti-potties when not in use for more air flow.
8. Huntmasters will stand 6 feet from the dogs after inspecting blankets and slip leads.
9. At the starting line, all exhibitors will stand 6 feet apart from one another.
10. Practice social distancing the best you can; especially around the FTS table, giving them space to work.
11. We ask that exhibitors approach the score sheets one person at a time and maintain social distance guidelines.
12. No self-serve ribbons anymore due to cross contamination.
13. Exhibitors who refuse to comply when reasonably asked to follow mask, sanitary or social distancing guidelines will be removed from the property.
14. All persons in attendance of these events MUST fill out a Waiver, attached....and submit it with their entries. Those submitting online entry will sign the waiver electronically.

I fully attest to the best of my knowledge that I do not have COVID-19 at the time of attending this event. I also attest that I have NOT been in contact with or exposed to any known carrier of COVID-19 within the past 14 days.
