ELIGIBILITY FOR JUNIOR COURSER AND QUALIFY COURSER

Only purebred Afghans, Azawakhs, Basenjis, Borzoi, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Portuguese Podengos, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Sloughis, Thai Ridgebacks and Whippets that are one year of age or older and have been registered with the American Kennel Club (AKC) or part of an AKC registered litter, or otherwise, if whelped outside of the United States of America and owned by a resident of the USA, or of a country with foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration and is registered with that registry or that have been granted an Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP), are eligible to participate in lure coursing tests and trials and be awarded the prefix title of Field Champion and the suffix titles of Junior Courser, Senior Courser or Master Courser. Those sight hounds enrolled in AKC's FSS which are eligible to compete in Conformation Miscellaneous class are eligible to compete in lure coursing tests and trials and be awarded the suffix titles of QC, JC, SC and MC. Spayed or neutered hounds are eligible to participate. Monorchid and cryptorchid hounds are ineligible to participate. Hounds may not be entered as "registration or ILP pending" Breed disqualifications apply.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Hounds must be one year of (age or older) on the day of the test. Hounds not preset at the time of roll call will be scratched after a 5 minute grace period. All hounds will be examined for AKC breed disqualifications. Spayed or neutered hounds (without breed disqualifications) may be entered. Bitches in season may not compete.

- The club reserves the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions

- An enforced \$5.00 fine will be imposed for any loose hound not competing in the test

- Only the Lure Operator, Hunt Master, Judge and handler of the hounds running in the test will be permitted near the lure machine

- Any person may, upon reasonable complaint, be asked to leave the grounds of the field trial by the Field Committee and may be disciplined by the AKC

- Entries will NOT be acknowledged by mail, but will be acknowledged by email if email address is provided on entry.

IMPORTANT: FAX, E-MAIL, or PHONE entries can not be accepted.

NICE THINGS TO KNOW

Directions to the Lure Coursing Field

From the North/West: I-64 to exit 220, Rte. VA 33/West Point, Left onto VA 30, Right onto VFW Road, Stay left to stay on VFW Road, Right onto Moorefield Road. From I-95 South (From Fredericksburg) take Exit 98 East towards West Point. **OR** From Rt. 30 turn onto Rt. 702, Industrial Park Road (right from West Point and left from I-95) then make an immediate left onto VFW Road. Go 1.5 miles and take a right onto Rt. 645, Moorefield Road.

From the East: From US-17N thru Gloucester, Left onto Adner Road/VA 14, Left onto VA 33, Right onto VA 30, Right on VFW Road, Stay left to stay on VFW Road, Right onto Moorefield Road. **OR** Take Exit 227 from I-64, go to Rt. 33, turn left, pick up Rt. 30, go into West Point and follow directions above.

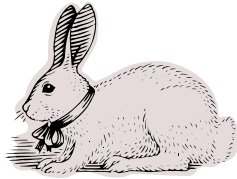

Field and Equipment Information: A battery-powered, continuous loop machine will be used. The lure will consist of white plastic bags. The field is mowed grass and basically level.



TEST HOURS: 12:00 p.m. until dusk

ROLL CALL: 12:00 pm. for all breeds

Testing will begin 30 minutes after the Coursing Ability Test has been completed, if later than 12:00 pm

Earlier roll call for Field Trial Committee, club members, lure operator, and judge

If you do not check-in by assigned time, you will not be able to participate

You will be expected to have complete info on your dog
