TEST/TRIAL HOURS

8:00 am until complete. Roll Call: Promptly at 9:00 am.

Day of Trial entries close 8:30 am. Substitutions (same owner) until 8:30 day of trial. Early roll call for Field committee, followed by draw. Entries will not be acknowledged by return mail, email or phone. If a hound passes the required QC Test, and the owner / handler wishes to enter the subsequent trial, the AKC Coursing Director has granted this club permission to accept trial entries following the test. Entries in this case will be accepted for a period of 15 minutes immediately following the announced finish of the QC Test.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Hounds must be one year of age or older on the day of the trial.
- All hounds will run twice, in trios if possible, or braces unless excused, dismissed or disqualified,
- Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched after a 5-minute grace period.
- Bitches in season and lame hounds will be excused with entry refunded.
- All hounds will be examined for breed disqualifications.
- Spayed or neutered hounds without breed disqualifications may be entered.

First time entries using ASFA or CKC Field Champion Waiver must submit a copy of the certificate with entry.

ELIGIBLE BREEDS AND REGISTRY

Afghan Hounds, Azawakhs, Basenjis, Borzoi, Cirneco Dell'Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizian Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Pharoah Hounds, Portuguese Podengo Pequeno, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Sloughis, Thai Ridgebacks, Norrbottenspets, Peruvian Inca Orchids, Portugese Pendengos and Whippets that are one year of age or older, that have been registered with the AKC, or are part of an AKC registered litter, or otherwise, if whelped outside the USA and owned by a resident of the USA, or of a country with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration and is registered with that registry, or that have been granted an indefinite listing privilege (ILP) or Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL), are eligible to participate in lure coursing tests and trials and be awarded the title of Field champion and the suffix titles of Junior Courser, Qualified Courser, Senior Courser or Master Courser only.

Spayed or neutered hounds are eligible to participate. Monocrid or cryptochrid hounds are ineligible to participate. Hounds may not be entered as "registration or ILP pending". Breed Disqualifications apply.

Portugese Podengos Pequenos and FSS breeds are not eligible to compete for Best in Field.

Any person, upon reasonable complaint, may be asked to leave the grounds of the field trial by the Field Trial Committee and may be disciplined by the AKC. Children must be under the control of their parent(s) or guardian(s) at all times.

COURSE PLANS

STAKES OFFERED

AKC JC and QC Tests – Offered both days

The **JUNIOR COURSER TEST** is open to all hounds of an eligible breed and at least 1 year of age. A hound running alone shall receive a certification from a judge on one date and a second certification from a different judge on a later date, stating that the hound completed at least a 600-yard course with a minimum of four turns. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption.

The **QUALIFIED COURSER TEST** is open to all hounds of an eligible breed at least 1 year of age. A hound (Qualifying Hound) running with another hound of the same breed – or another breed of similar running style – (Testing Hound) shall receive certification from a licensed judge. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption, sufficiently course the lure and not course the Testing Hound. The judge will certify that the Qualifying Hound ran cleanly and did not appear to represent a hazard to the Testing Hound at any point in the qualifying course. This certificate is required to enter a hound in an Open Stake.

The handler presenting the Qualifying Hound shall be responsible for providing the Testing Hound for the qualifying course. Upon successful completion of the Qualified Courser Test, the judge completes a certificate and awards it to the handler. This certificate must be submitted to the host club with the hound's first entry in an Open Stake. The certificate must be included when the results of the trial are sent to the AKC.

AKC REGULAR STAKES:

OPEN: Open to all sighthounds that have attained at least one of the following: AKC Qualified Courser Title, CKC Field Champion, ASFA FCH Title. Championship points may be awarded from this stake. Whippets who have earned and AKC Field Championship are not eligible to enter Open.

OPEN VETERAN: Open to all Sighthounds, which are eligible to enter either Open or Special Stake, and are of Veteran age as determined by their Parent Breed Club. Championship of LCX points may be awarded from this stake.

SPECIAL: Open to all sighthounds that are eligible to enter the Open Stake and have earned their AKC Field Championship Titles. LCX Points may be awarded from this stake.

SINGLES STAKE:

SINGLES: Will be offered. Open to all sighthounds. Sighthounds with breed disqualifications are eligible to enter.

HOUNDS UNDER DISQUALIFICATION from AKC, ASFA, or CKC Field Trials are NOT eligible to be entered.

BEST IN FIELD will be offered.

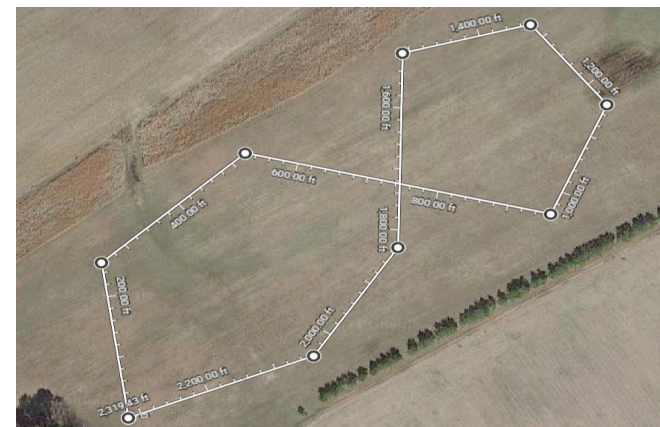

From LaQuest, turn right on Carsley Rd (Rt 615), turn right on Rt 31, Turn left on Rt 450. Rt 460 turns into Pruden Blvd in Suffolk. Turn left on Godwin Blvd. Sentara will be on your right in 2 miles. Total trip time approx. 45 minutes.

CAMPING

Camping is allowed on the field. Large RV's and Travel Trailers should park on the gravel driveway only. RVs need to notify the FTS in advance so we know how many to plan for. Please do not show up Friday evening after dark as there are no lights to show the entrance. Camping on the field is free, but no hookups or water are available.

MOTEL ACCOMODATIONS

Red Roof Inn Williamsburg: 824 Capitol Landing Rd, Williamsburg, VA 23185. RRI Williamsburg is the preferred hotel for their multiple pet friendly policy. DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL

From the North -From Hopewell, take Rt. 10 East for 29.7 miles. Turn right onto Martin Luther King Highway (VA 40) for five miles, turn left onto Carsley Road (VA 615) for 3.7 miles. Then turn right onto Carsley Road and field will be on the right in about 1/2 mile.

From the South -From Emporia, get on Rt. 95 North towards Richmond for 19.8 miles, take Exit 31 (VA 40) towards Waverly/Sussex Courthouse for 28.1 miles. Turn right onto Carsley Road (VA 615) for 3.7 miles. Turn right again onto Carsley Road and field will be on the right in about 1/2 mile.

From Jamestown/Williamsburg - Take VA 31 towards the Jamestown/Scotland Ferry. Ferry is free, but check schedule for departure times. Continue on VA 31 for 14.6 miles, then turn right onto Carsley Road. The field is on the left in 2.9 miles. Ferry schedule can be found here: <http://www.virginiadot.org/travel/ferry-jamestown.asp>

From Suffolk - Take 460 West for 20.7 miles. Turn right onto VA 31 for about 5 miles. Turn left onto Carsley Road for 2.9 miles to the field on the left.

From Hampton/Newport News -Take the James River Bridge (Rt 17S), then turn right onto Brewer's Neck Blvd. (Rt. 32/258) for 2.8 miles. Turn right onto Benn's Church Blvd. (Rt. 10) for 22 miles. Turn left at the light in Surry (VA 10/31) for 10.3 miles. Turn right onto Carsley Road for 2.9 miles to the field on the left.

From Portsmouth/Chesapeake – Take 17 North into Isle of Wight County (Carrollton). Turn left onto Brewers Neck Blvd. (Rt. 32/258) for 2.8 miles. Turn right onto Benn's Church Blvd. (Rt. 10) for 22 miles. Turn left at the light in Surry (VA 10/31) for 10.3 miles. Turn right onto Carsley Road for 2.9 miles to the field on the left.
